Learn to Lead! Teach What You Know! Earn \$\$\$ or Community Service Credit!

Madrih (f: *madriha*) is the Hebrew word for leader. Kehillat Israel's Madrihim Program is designed for post 8th-12th grade teens who are interested in earning money* or community service** points by contributing their unique talents and skills to the Kehillat Israel community. Specifically, KI teens are invited to become *Madrihim* in one of two unique ways:

- **Madrihim Beit Sefer (School Leaders)**
Teens who choose this option are assigned to work with a teacher in one of our Religious School classrooms, in the Religious School office or as support for audio/visual tasks. As Classroom Madrihim, teens will assist teachers in a variety of ways including one-on-one tutoring, leading small group activities, classroom organization and administrative work. Teens assigned to the Administrative Office will help with a variety of school-related administrative tasks. Teens assigned to the school's Audio/Visual tasks will be assigned to photograph students and support the technological needs of the school. *Madrihim Beit Sefer may work on Sunday mornings, Monday afternoons and/or Tuesday afternoons.*
- **Madrihim T'fillah (Prayer Leaders)**
Teens that choose this option will either help the Rabbis with the 4th - 6th grade monthly PaLs Shabbat or the Saturday Morning Leaner's Service. Responsibilities will include greeting guests, preparing ritual items, leading short prayers and assisting as needed. This is a great option for those teens who loved the experience of having a Bar or Bat Mitzvah and want to further develop their Prayer-Leadership skills. Teens with specialized audio visual skills should also apply to this Madrihim T'fillah program as we are looking to fill several Videographer positions. *Madrihim T'fillah may work on either Friday evenings or Saturday mornings.*

MADRIHIM POSITIONS AVAILABLE

Primary Grade Classroom Madrihim work in either kindergarten, 1st or 2nd grade classrooms. Responsibilities are varied and may include making sure each child is engaged, helping with snack, assisting with art or other hands-on activities, taking attendance, reading aloud from story books, leading games, helping with basic Hebrew letter and clean up, etc.

Hebrew Classroom Madrihim work in any of the 3rd – 7th grade Hebrew classrooms, assisting the teacher by helping individual students, leading small groups, leading games or helping to keep the children engaged. Ability to read and understand the prayers at the assigned grade level is essential. Please specify the grade level if you wish to work in a Hebrew classroom. 3rd grade Hebrew Classroom Madrihim will also assist with the Judaic Studies portion of the curriculum.

Judaic Studies Madrihim work in the Judaic Studies classrooms at the 4th – 6th grade level. They assist the teacher in a variety of ways, often leading small group discussions, helping with art projects, etc.. Please specify the grade level if you wish to work in a Judaic Studies classroom. The following information might be useful to you in determining your grade level choice. 4th Grade Core Curriculum: Israel. 5th Grade Core Curriculum: Israel. 6th Grade Core Curriculum: Torah, Comparative Judaism and Lifecycles

Audio/Visual Madrihim will be responsible for photographing/videoing the activities of the religious school, posting images to KI website and providing technical support as needed.

Administrative Office Madrihim will have a variety of general office duties including making deliveries to classrooms, organizing storage materials, collecting and tallying tzedakah, checking books in and out of library and more.

T'fillah (Prayer) Madrihim will have a variety of responsibilities during either the monthly PaLS Shabbat for 4th-6th graders or the community wide Saturday Morning Learners Minyan. Duties will include greeting guests, preparing ritual items, leading short prayers and assisting as needed.

T'fillah (Prayer) Videographer Madrihim will work with the Rabbis to record and edit the Saturday Mornings Learner's Minyan.
