## 4th Street Mystery Bus Adventure

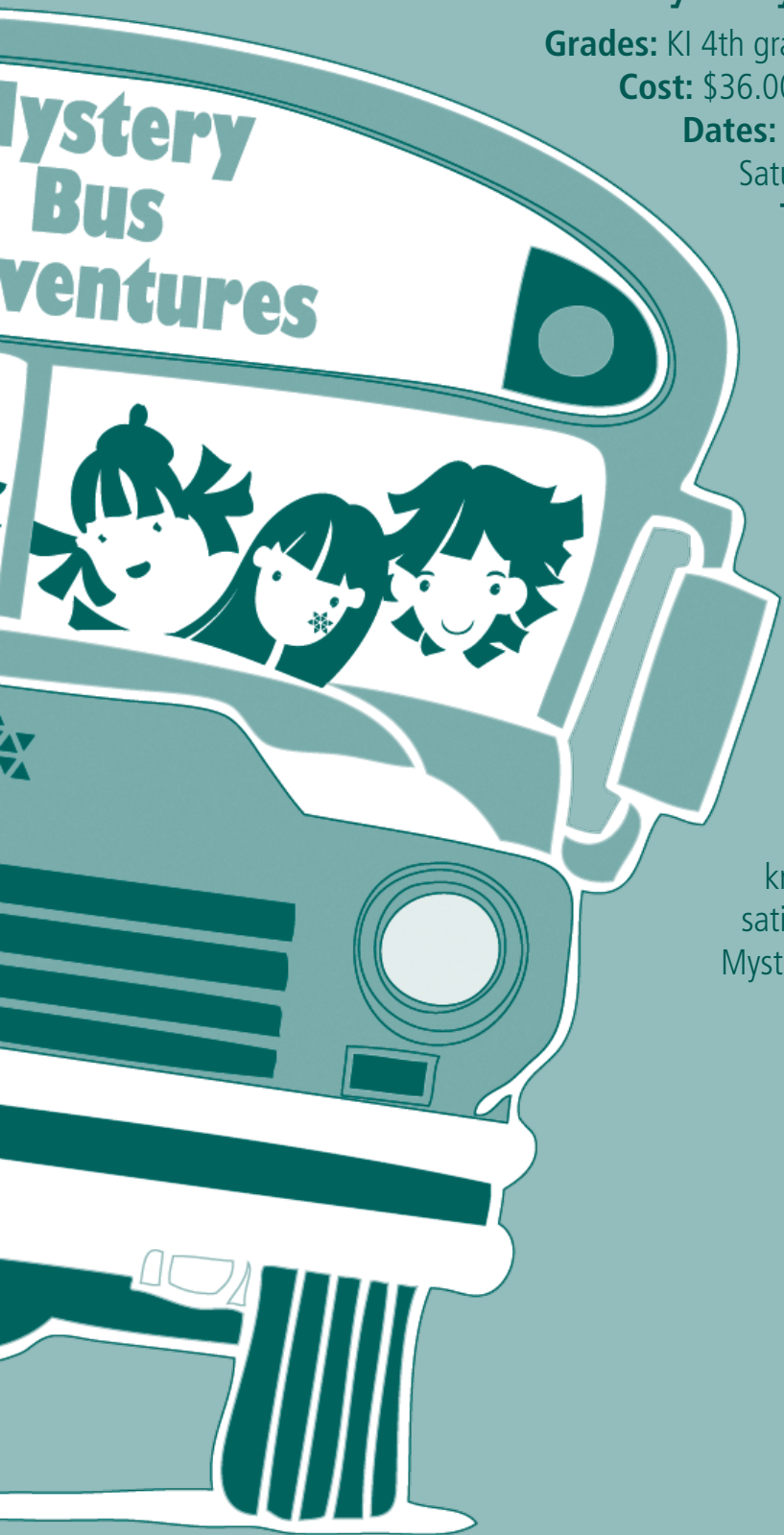
